For animal lovers:

Overall, Thailand is a truly fantastic place to honeymoon—there are beaches, bustling cities, and jungles. At Anantara Golden Triangle Elephant Camp and Resort, guests get (very) up close and personal with the rescued elephants. (The resort is part of The Golden Triangle Asian Elephant Foundation which "works with our partner hotels to give and promote ethical work for those elephants that are able, while providing a safe, healthy environment for those that are not.") Situated on the verdant land of Chang Rai, the property is perched upon on a ridge that overlooks Thailand, Laos, and Myanmar. The "three country view suites" allow you to take your morning coffee or evening wine on a balcony with pinch-me vistas of each country that often include spectacular wildlife. There's an elephant picnic offered, where couples tuck into a personalized lunch for two surrounded by a group of snacking elephants. There's elephant yoga: an hour-long practice with an elephant companion in a paddy sala. And even a VIP regal elephant arrival, where couples can travel by private car from the airport to the historic riverside town of Chiang Saen, then board a private long-tail boat and glide down the Mekong River to a welcoming committee of gentle giants.
